

About the "Arbeitgeber der Zukunft" (Employer of the Future) award:

The German Innovation Institute for Sustainability and Digitization (DIND) awards the "Employer of the Future" prize to companies for their future viability and high quality as employers. The initiative is supported by former Federal Minister of Economics Brigitte Zypries. The award helps companies to position themselves in the "war for talents" in order to attract and retain talent despite the shortage of skilled workers.

The award honors innovative companies with a clear digitization strategy, pursue sustainability goals and offer attractive working conditions. The focus here is on modern

leadership and employee friendliness. For example, flat hierarchies, flexible compensation models and employee benefits, as well as individual training and development opportunities are incorporated into a holistic picture that is drawn up on the basis of an assessment matrix, which is compiled with the input from experts from the worlds of business and science. This year, for the first time, the awards will be presented at several Networking events.
